State of play on the implementation of the EU Directive on Restructuring and Insolvency (2019/1023) in all EU member states

The latest article will be published to focus on legislative amendments to be introduced in *Poland*, which is the latest country to consider implementing the EU Directive on Restructuring and Insolvency and whose progress is still available thanks to our dedicated tracker (last update as at November 2024) at: www.insoleurope.org/tracker-eu-directive-on-restructuring-and-insolvency

As at 18 October 2024, the Polish government has uploaded another version of the draft implementation of EU Restructuring Directive. The time given for consultation was only one week (7 days), so things

are now moving 'faster'.

Once adopted, the insolvency reform will be summarised by our INSOL Europe country coordinator for Poland: Paweł Kuglarz from Tatara & Partners Restructuring & Insolvency Law Firm.
